Abstract Guidelines

Authors are required to submit up to 300-word abstract for all categories. Abstracts should be written in English. For Bulgarian participants Abstracts should be written in English and Bulgarian.

Abstracts should be prepared using the *AbstractTemplate-Online-2019EN* and *AbstractTemplate-Online-2019BG*. Inclusive with all abstract template elements (title, affiliation, abstract body, references and keywords) submissions must not be longer than one template page. Abstracts must be submitted electronically by email ba-seminar2019@abv.bg in the form of an MS Word document and PDF document.

Abstract submission deadline: 20 February 2019

The abstracts in English and Bulgarian will be printed in the brochure of the Seminar.

Full-text Guidelines

Full text is only required for paper category. Full-text papers should be prepared using the *Full-text Template-Online-2019EN* or *Full-text Template-Online-2019BG*, should follow writing guidelines and should not exceed 10 pages. Papers should be submitted electronically by email ba-seminar2019@abv.bg in the form of an MS Word document and PDF document

Full text submission deadline: 30 April 2019

The submissions will be examined and the authors will be notified of the outcome by 10 May 2019. The final versions of full-texts should be submitted by 20 May 2019. These papers will be published in the Annual of the UACEG-Sofia as
