VIII BULGARIAN-AUSTRIAN SEMINAR Hydrological hazards and related problems 30-31 May, 2019, Sofia, Bulgaria

The Department of Hydraulic Engineering of the University of Architecture, Civil Engineering and Geodesy (UACEG), Sofia, Bulgaria, and the Institute for Hydraulic Engineering and Water Resources Management at the Vienna University of Technology, Austria organize Bulgarian-Austrian Seminars since 2003. These events bring together researchers, hydraulic engineers and hydrologists, owners of facilities and representatives of the regulatory bodies for presentations and discussions of results from research and experiments. The Seminar includes plenary and poster sessions.

- Hydrological Risk Assessment of Old Dams and Facilities
- Emerging Technologies in Data Analysis, Hydroinformatics, and Climate Informatics
- Case studies

Submissions for Contributions

The seminar will be composed of several types of contributions, such as full-papers and posters. Each has different requirements and restrictions regarding the length, time allocation and content. In each category at least one of the authors of an accepted contribution should register and take part in the seminar to make the presentation.

Abstract Submission

Authors are required to submit a 300 word abstract for all categories by 10 December 2018. Abstracts should be written in English. Authors who are unsure of correct English usage should have their manuscript reviewed for clarity by a colleague whose native language is English or seek help at a professional English writing and editing service. For Bulgarian participants Abstracts should be written in English and Bulgarian.

Abstracts should be prepared using the *Abstract Template and Formatting Guide*. Inclusive with all abstract template elements (title, affiliation, abstract body, references and keywords) submissions must not be longer than one template page. Abstracts must be submitted electronically by email ba-seminar2019@abv.bg in the form of an MS Word document and PDF document.

Contributions will be reviewed and the authors will be notified of the outcome by 15 December 2018. Please note that your abstract will be included in the print and the online version of the Book of Abstracts only if you have registered and participated in the seminar to make the presentation. Please, have a look at Important dates' section for further information.

Full-text Submission

Full text is only required for paper category. Full-text papers should be prepared using the *Full-text Template*, should follow *Writing guidelines* and should not exceed 10 pages. Papers should be submitted electronically by email ba-seminar2019@abv.bg. Full text submission deadline is 30 April 2019.

The submissions will be examined and the authors will be notified of the outcome by 10 May 2019. The final versions of full-texts should be submitted by 20 May 2019. These papers will be published in the proceedings e-book.
